- 1) Fear of being sued or blamed for what happened
- 2) Too busy or indifferent to contributing to the general advancement of knowledge or to be placed on hold at some institutional call center.
- 3) Ambition - to collect and publish a personal series of cases [*or in the case of veterinarians, too worried about decreased revenues*]
- 4) Vet feeling guilty about possibly of having contributed to the adverse effect himself
- 5) Complacency - the mistaken belief that only safe drugs are USDA/UMA licensed
- 6) Ignorance of the need for reporting
- 7) Sheepishness about reporting a mere suspicion
